5.) Please give a complete, detailed list of the **specific** products you intend to sell at the Market and the approximate crop space to be planted. For greenhouse, that can be the number of pots, baskets, flats, etc. For fields, the number of rows, plants, acres, etc. Please indicate approximate growing space/numbers devoted to each crop. For instance, if you are growing 600 tomato plants, indicate 600 plants as your quantity; ½ acre of tomatoes, indicate ½ acre as your quantity. If you are offering bedding plants, perennials, or other horticulture products, indicate the total greenhouse/shade house/outdoor growing area. **If more space is needed, please attach additional sheets.**

NOTE: You will only be allowed to sell the items on this list. If, after being inspected, you wish to sell additional items not on this list, it will require another inspection at your cost which will include inspector's time at \$10.00/hour including driving time, and mileage at 50 cents per mile round trip from inspector's starting point.

Application fee: Yearly membership fee is \$125.00 for one market space, plus a \$10.00 stall fee each Saturday market attended and a \$5.00 stall fee each Tuesday market attended. One additional market space may be purchased for \$125.00 at the start of the season. For any application received after March 15th, the fee is \$150.00 per space. Members who purchase a second stall must pay a \$25.00 stall fee each Saturday market attended and a \$10.00 each Tuesday market. Tuesday markets in April, September and October will have no stall fees. **Electricity is a \$5.00 per sale day additional charge** and no generators are allowed. There must be a farm/business inspection for all members before their first sale day at the market, and there may be random spot inspections during the growing season. It is the vendor's responsibility to schedule an inspection before the first day of intended sales. Please allow a reasonable amount of time for the market to respond to your requested inspection. It should be a week or more in a busy time of year. Please send a check made out to **Southern Kentucky Regional Farmers Market** for total amount along with your completed application and all required permits to: **SKYRFM, 976 Hill Road~ Bowling Green, KY 42103**. The membership fee is refundable if membership is not approved.

I have read and understand the Farmers Market By-Laws and market guidelines.
